Dear Judge Newchurch:

On May 16, 2008 the Applicant provided the ALJ and all parties a bates-stamped copy of the Application. The Applicant anticipates this will be the final version and the one it will go to hearing on. This bates-stamped copy of the Application has some minor changes from the copy which was approved by the TCEQ and has been on file in the public library. These changes have been submitted to the TCEQ and the Executive Director has conducted a preliminary review of the proposed changes and agrees they should be included as revisions to the Application. These revisions are administrative in nature and incorporate two basic changes. First, it was revised to reflect the name change from BFI Waste Systems of North America Inc., to BFI Waste Systems of North America, LLC, as approved in the permit transfer modification issued on April 3, 2008. incorporated address certain various revisions were to typographical/consistency items which the TCEQ MSW staff identified subsequent to the time the Application was deemed technically complete and the draft permit was issued.

The Staff indicated to us that they would like these administrative changes to the application addressed either through prefiled testimony or through revisions to the Application, if a procedural opportunity presented itself. In light of the fact that the Applicant received approval for a permit transfer modification to change its name from BFI Waste Systems of North America, Inc., to BFI Waste Systems of North America, LLC, a procedural opportunity was created. The additional minor administrative changes included are summarized in the attached memo. That memo lists the items as identified by the staff and summarizes the changes as
