GREEN GROUP, CONCERNED RESIDENTS HASH IT OUT - Green Group Holdings hosted the first of a series of public meetings on Tuesday evening to discuss plans for a multi-use development which will include a landfill, proposed in the area near the intersection of Highway 183 and FM 1185 in rural Caldwell County. Neighbors and area residents have been vocally opposed to the development, and have organized a group to oppose the development. Green Group will host another meeting at their offices, 205 S.
