The enclosed revisions are submitted on behalf of 130 Environmental Park, LLC, for the referenced permit application. As recently discussed, the revisions in the permit application are related to two items:

- 1. A typographical error was identified in the Part II, Appendix IIC, Traffic Impact Analysis prepared by Lee Engineering.
- 2. The applicant has determined that an additional monitoring well was desired along the northwest site perimeter. The addition of MW-26 is included with this submittal, primarily in Attachment F, Appendix F1. Additional drawings showing the monitoring well locations have also been revised as well in Part II, Appendix IIA; Part III, Attachment D, Attachment D1, Attachment D2, Attachment H, Attachment I and Attachment J.

In addition, we have identified two other minor corrections that we wanted to make and have included those in the submittal. They are, 1) correcting the applicant's mailing address in Attachment I – Post Closure Plan, page I-4; and 2) the site sequencing drawings in Part II, specifically Drawings IIA.15, 16, 17, 18, and 19, have been corrected to make them consistent with the monitoring well phasing plan in the table on Drawing F1-1. MW-2 was shown on those drawings, although it would not yet have been installed.
