



**A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE POST OAK CLEAN GREEN LANDFILL**

**WHEREAS**, The Alamo Area Council of Governments' Board of Directors finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the AACOG Region to oppose the permitting of the Post Oak Clean Green Landfill; and

**WHEREAS**, The proposed location of the Post Oak Clean Green Landfill facility raises air flight and water concerns for the nearby area as well as for the entire Alamo Area Council of Governments Region; and

**WHEREAS**, The Randolph Air force Base Airfield is located outside the distance requirements established in Texas Administrative Code §330.545, the rule also contains a separate provision beyond the distance requirements stating that "Landfills disposing putrescible waste should not be located in areas where the attraction of birds can cause significant bird hazard to low flying aircrafts" 30TAC § 330.545 (d); and

**WHEREAS**, The military aircraft patterns differ from the civilian aircraft patterns entering the Seguin area, the proximity of the proposed landfill site to the military flight patterns and the expected rise in bird activity could lead to an increased risk of bird strikes; and

**WHEREAS**, The current population growth and projected growth in the IH10 and IH35 corridors as well as the SAWS commitment for water to the Region's Military Bases requires the protection of the Carrizo-Wilcox Aquifer which already provides the drinking water for seven cities and five counties; and

**WHEREAS**, The proposed landfill location with respect to the Carrizo-Wilcox Aquifer has the potential to contaminate the aquifer and surface waters; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Alamo Area Council of Governments' Board of Directors is in opposition of the Post Oak Clean Green Landfill.
